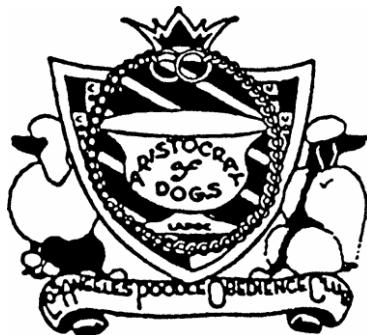

SPECIAL NOTICE, SCRATCH POLICY.

Refunds for bitches that come into season after close of entries: All entry fees, less a processing fee of \$4.00 for the first class and \$2.00 for each additional class will be refunded for the bitch in season if the Trial Secretary receives WRITTEN notice of withdrawal no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. A letter from your veterinarian may be required. Bitches in season will not be allowed on AKC showground.

OTHER NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS.

A Service Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking test. The recording fee is to be collected by the showing club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the First entry only. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)

NO DOG WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS EXCEPT THOSE ELIGIBLE TO BE SHOWN. (Chap. 11 Sec. 11)

No person who has previously handled a dog that has won a Companion Dog Title in the Obedience Ring at a Licensed Trial may enter or handle a dog in the Novice A Class.

EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS

The **AKC** and **LAPOC** believe that the well-being of dogs and participants is of paramount importance at any event and the **officers of LAPOC** will take action if and when difficult weather conditions such as - but not limited to - **extreme** heat, rain, floods, snowstorms, hurricanes, and/or riots, earthquakes, or other conditions may conclude in banning dogs or participants at or on the way to the event, they may cancel this event.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on an entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, (section 3).
4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Caine Partners™ Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All-American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dame information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

*I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury, damage to this dog.
